

## North London Flyers Flying Club Site Rules

Site Location: Holly Hill Farm, The Ridgeway, Enfield, Middlesex, EN2 8AN

### 1. General

1.1 Terms used in this document are the same as those defined in section 1 of the Club Constitution.

### 2. General.

2.1 All users of the site must observe the following general rules:

- 2.1.1 All litter is to be removed from the site at the end of the day and the flying site and its surrounds are to be kept tidy;
- 2.1.2 All gates opened are to be closed securely;
- 2.1.3 Cars must be parked in the designated parking areas only;
- 2.1.4 Vehicles must observe a site speed limit of 10 mph;
- 2.1.5 Livestock should not be unduly disturbed;
- 2.1.6 Care should be taken if retrieving models from areas of crop growth. Persons should walk between stands of crop growth where possible. Notice is drawn to the £20 property damage excess provision of the BMFA Insurance Schedule: if a claim for crop damage is made on their insurance, the person who committed the damage is liable to pay this excess;
- 2.1.7 Agricultural vehicles have right of way at all times. Cars must be parked so as not to obstruct their movement;
- 2.1.8 Public rights of way which pass by the Flying Site must not be obstructed or users of such hindered in any way;
- 2.1.9 No building is to be entered without permission of the land holder or his agents;
- 2.1.10 The reasonable requests of the land holder or his agents must be complied with;
- 2.1.11 All Club Members and flying Guests are to carry their Club identification AND BMFA Membership details at all times on the site. Only together do these two documents constitute Club Identification. They must produce them if requested to do so by the land holder or his agents. Anyone failing to comply may be asked to leave the site.

### 3. Permitted Disciplines

3.1 The following types of discipline only are permitted at this site:

- 3.1.1 Radio Control Power (RCP)
- 3.1.2 Radio Control Fixed Wing (RCFW)
- 3.1.3 Radio Control Helicopter (RCH )
- 3.1.4 Silent Flight (SF)

3.2 The site is currently unsuitable for Gas Turbine powered models.

### 4. Flying Times and Restrictions

4.1 The flying times to be observed at the site are as follows:

- 4.1.1 Mondays to Saturdays (inclusive) 10:00 a.m. until ½ hour before sunset.
- 4.1.2 Sundays 10:00 a.m. until 5:30 p.m.
- 4.1.3 No Flying on Christmas Day and on other days as notified.

4.2 The site must be vacated within ½ hour of the cessation of flying each day. ***This is particularly important on Sundays when the farm access is closed at 6:00 p.m. Members and their guests must strictly observe this condition.***

4.3 The following restrictions must be observed:

- 4.3.1 Do not fly low over livestock, walkers on footpaths or agricultural vehicles.
- 4.3.2 Only Club Members and their authorised Guests are permitted to fly at the site
- 4.3.3 No person will be permitted to fly at the site unless:
  - 4.3.3.1 There is a Club Safety Officer present; or
  - 4.3.3.2 They are specifically authorised to do so by the Full Committee.
- 4.3.4 Prospective new members may be invited to fly at the site by the Club. They may be charged by the Club for training. Unless they already hold BMFA Insurance, they will only be permitted to fly on a buddy lead and this will hold until their Club membership is accepted.
